Student Life at CITNC

Student life at Cambridge Institute of Technology–North Campus is inclusive, supportive, and student-centric, with a strong emphasis on academic support, financial assistance, and residential facilities.

Hostel for Boys and Girls:

The institution provides separate hostel facilities for boys and girls to ensure safety, discipline, and a conducive learning environment. The boys' hostel has the capacity to accommodate up to 200 students. Hostel facilities for girl students are arranged by the management for all interested candidates.

In addition, eligible students are accommodated in Backward Classes and Minority Hostels operated under schemes of the Government of Karnataka. These hostels are intended to support students from backward classes and minority communities by providing essential facilities such as accommodation, food, and clothing, thereby promoting inclusive access to higher education.

Student Scholarship:

- A significant number of students of CITNC will benefit from various government and private scholarship schemes. The students admitted through Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) will get the scholarship under the SSP scheme from Government of Karnataka.
- **Eligibility for scholarship**
- For CET students admitted students full financial assistance has been provided by the Government of Karnataka through the State Scholarship Portal (SSP) for all the students belonging to marginalized communities, including Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), and Other Backward Classes (OBC).
- The meritorious management and COMEDK admitted students are supported through Karnataka Labour Welfare Scheme, Sitaram Jindal Trust Scholarship, Dharmasthala trust Scholarship etc.
